

OHIO CLUB HOLIDAY 2012

September 15 – 23, 2012

In September we look forward to exploring some of the marvelous roads and sights of Ohio, the Buckeye State (named after the Ohio buckeye tree), starting from the Ohio River city of Cincinnati in the south-west corner of the state and traversing the state to the shores of Lake Erie in the north before returning to Cincinnati.



Bounded on the east by Pennsylvania and West Virginia, on the south by Kentucky, on the west by Indiana and on the north by Michigan and Lake Erie, Ohio offers a great variety of topographies from the rugged south-east to the glacial plains in the north-west, with a number of major cities, including Cincinnati, Cleveland, the capital Columbus and Dayton as the top four metropolitan areas.

Our travel routes, selected by Club-members Peg Valentine and Scott Hughes, will take us from Cincinnati to

the picturesque Hocking Hills Park area of Columbus, from there south-east to Columbus to join the BMW CCA's 2012 Oktoberfest for a day, and from there north to Cleveland at the shores of Lake Erie. In Cleveland we will visit the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame, and after a night in Cleveland we'll re-join the BMW CCA at the Mid Ohio race track, where we hope to be able to run a few parade laps before pro-

ceeding on to the eastern outskirts of Dayton for a visit to the U.S. Air Force Museum. The final day will be available to explore Cincinnati and environs.

- The Ohio Club Holiday 2012 will start on Saturday, September 15 and conclude on Sunday, September 23.
- Start and Finish will both be in Cincinnati, OH.
- The week will include 5 driving days through some of Ohio's most attractive back-country roads, participation in the BMW CCA's Concours d'Elegance near Columbus, a visit to the

very popular Rock & Roll Hall of Fame in Cleveland, plus visits to the U.S. Air Force Museum and also the Packard Museum in Dayton, and finally a day of sightseeing in Cincinnati.

- Daily driving distances will range from less than 100 miles to a maximum of about 250 miles.

- Participation is open to all members of the BMW V&CCCA with BMW cars (or BMW-engined cars) at least 25 years old, plus Z1s and Z8s.

- A minimum of 12 and a maximum of 18 participating vehicles / teams will be accepted.

- Cost per person will be \$1,950 for double hotel room occupancy, and \$2,450 for single room occupancy.

- This cost includes overnight accommodations for 8
